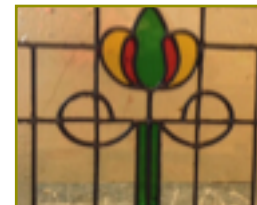

Tassel Making Tutor: Julie Hennessy

This class will primarily be for making beaded tassels using seed beads, larger beads and Lucite flowers on a wire frame. However, many things tie in with this, from making ear rings and pendants to pincushions hung in small glasses and pincushion rings.

Students are welcome to bring & use their own bead stash, but I will have a full range of materials available on the day. Materials costs will vary with what you make, anywhere from \$5 to \$60 plus a small fee for general materials which will also depend on what you make.

Material costs & needs list will be on the website & sent to you.

Class will be held at Stash Palace.

Watercolour Painting Tutor: Ivan Button

During our couple of days of ‘splashing paint around’ through demonstration and goal setting, the aim is for each artist to discover ways to enliven their paintings, gain inspiration, be encouraged, have fun and complete an artwork to take home.

Stained Glass Lead Lighting Tutor: Kay Nelson

Kay has run a successful Lead lighting studio in Christchurch for the past 25 years. We have taught at the Autumn School several times over the years and love the enthusiasm and energy that the local North Cantabrians put into learning new skills and crafts.

Students will get to make a Leadlight Panel approx. 500 x 500, or a copperfoil project.

Students will learn the basics of cutting glass and then will create a panel or hanging using either lead or the copper foiling technique.

We can do starter packs for students but will also talk to students before the weekend about their projects and what to bring.

Class will be held at Hanmer Springs School.

Wet Felting Tutor: Jane Dolan

Felting is a passion of Jane’s. She is a member of “Southern Felters Group” and also a member of “Creative Fibre NZ”. She is very involved in exhibitions, felting retreats & workshops. She has recently been selling her felt at the Halswell Market and online.

This course is designed to give felters a good grounding in a variety of methods & techniques using wet felting.

Students will make a sample square, felted flower & progress on to make a larger item such as a scarf or bag.

Jane will have some Felting Kits available to buy at weekend at \$25.

Dog Obedience and Training - ONE DAY COURSE Saturday or Sunday Tutor: Julie Donovan

This course is for all levels and ability. Julie has been a professional canine behaviourist and dog trainer since 2006. She has completed ‘principles of canine behaviour’ through Massey University and competes in obedience competitions at a national level. The focus of this course is the four basics of ‘sit’, stay, walking on lead properly and coming back when called. Manners training, nutrition and some fun agility exercises will also be covered.

All dogs need to be fully vaccinated, including against kennel cough to attend this course. Proof of this must be provided at the beginning of the course.

No extra costs are applied to this course.

Upholstery Tutor: Steve McDonald

Steve has been an Upholsterer for 30 plus years and been teaching for the last 17 years. We have a workshop in Christchurch that employs 7 full-time staff.

He is looking forward to teaching at Autumn School. Students will learn how to strip the old fabric off the object, take a pattern, sew a new one, then put back on the object.

This class will be small with only 8 students so register early.

Steve will contact all students well before the course to discuss their project and tell them what to bring.

Students to bring your own mug for morning and afternoon teas which are provided.

Boyle River Photography Field Trip Tutors: Rod Morris and Carl Thompson

Class and accommodation at Boyle River Outdoor Education Centre, (03 315 7082) approximately 45 minute drive on SH7 into Lewis Pass from Hanmer Springs. Please note we would like all students to be there by **7 pm Friday** night as there will be an introduction to the course then.

This course is for all levels of ability. Tutors are happy to be contacted for any queries.

Both Rod and Carl are well-known award winning, nature photographers throughout New Zealand and overseas.

Rod is a published author and his work can be viewed at www.rodmorris.co.nz. Carl is a national photography judge with many years of experience in field work. This field trip will be held at the Boyle River Outdoor Education Centre where all participants will stay for the weekend.

The students can expect to learn how to use their

camera and micro lens to take shots of landscapes, bird life, fungi and much more.

Plus extra cost of \$60 per student for 2 night’s accommodation. Please include this with your course fee.

Sewing/ Design/ Dressmaking Tutor: Raelene Bleeker

Suitable for all abilities.

Raelene has over 30 years dressmaking and designing experience, and she is also a qualified colour consultant and wardrobe planner. She has taught all levels of sewing at night school for over eight years.

Participants at this course can choose from the following: Make a skirt or cushion, Pattern making/ taking a pattern off existing clothing. Re-vamp and refit an item of clothing into a new and exciting outfit e.g. winter coat. Raelene will talk about colour consultation and fitting your wardrobe to your figure.

Extra costs will be based on the project you choose. Some materials will be offered for sale at the class. Raelene will contact students about their projects.
